Social worker is a well-established and respected profession especially since the enactment of the Social Worker Law No. 14 of 2019. Coupled with Law on Social Welfare No. 11 of 2009, which has been legalized for a long time, has further strengthened the existence of professional social work in Indonesian context.

Social workers contribute in assisting psychological and social problems holistically and comprehensively, both at the individual, group and community level. Alumni of social work education are spread in various institutions, both government-owned such as the Ministry of Social Affairs, Ministry of Law and Human Rights, Rehabilitation Center, Correctional Institution, BNPB and BNN. Our alumni also works at private institution and community-based organization such as NGOs, Hospitals, CSR and so on.

Social Work Study Program (SWSP) has an accreditation with "A" predicate; has been established since January 11, 2010 in collaboration with CIDA and McGill University Canada. The SWSP curriculum is compiled through benchmarking with national and international tertiary institutions.

A total of 9 credits practicum is conducted in a real setting in various social service institutions. The SWSP already has number of MOUs where professional supervisors from partner institution are able to assist students when working directly with clients to solve social problems.
